Will the Counselling process be offline or online?	The Counselling process will be online only.
What is the online Counselling process?	The Candidate declared eligible in NEET UG 2025 can participate in Counselling process. They have to upload necessary information and documents as per the instructions. They have to pay Registration fee (Non refundable) before filling and locking the choices. The candidates who are allotted any seat have to deposit provisional tuition fee online before document verification by the Admission Committee.
ii) Choice filling	
Where do I find the Choice Filling Option for Counselling?	Choice filling option will activate only after the registration fee is paid and reconciled.
How can I fill Choice?	From the drop down select "Course". All Colleges where this course runs will be displayed in the second drop down. From there choose "College" and click on update button. Fill all choices and press "Save" button to save your choices. In the end you must take printout of filled choices and discuss with your Parents/ Teachers/Friends etc. You can modify /add /delete your choices as many times as you want till the closing time as per schedule.
How many choices should I fill?	There is no limit for maximum choices. You can fill all available choices. However you should fill a higher number of choices so that you don't miss this opportunity.
Can I modify my choices?	Yes, you can modify your choices till the last date of choice filling as per schedule.
How I know about BC-A / BC-B category and Creamy / Non-Creamy Layer Certificates?	Candidates applying under BCA / BCB category should submit Creamy / Non Creamy Layer certificate issued by competent authority as per Government of Haryana No. 40/13/2024-1SW Dated 16.07.2024, by the Department of Welfare of Schedule Castes and Backward Classes. Certificates issued by Competent authority after 01.04.2025 will only be considered valid, for deciding eligibility, for admission under BCA / BCB category.
How I know about EWS category and Income & Asset Certificate?	Candidates applying under EWS category should submit Income and Asset certificate issued by competent authority as per Haryana government Notification dated 08.08.2025. Certificates issued by Competent authority after 01.04.2025 will only be considered valid, for deciding eligibility, for admission under EWS category.
How I know about SC / SC Deprived category Certificate?	Candidates applying under SC / SC Deprived category should submit category certificate issued by competent authority as per Haryana government Notification dated 15.05.2020 and letter dated 13.11.2024.
What if, the candidate do not fill choices or fail to save it?	It is mandatory to save choices, otherwise your choices will not be considered and you will not be eligible for allocation.

Can I take the help of my elders / cyber cafe / friends in choice filling?	You can take help from another person at your own risk. Be cautious to check what has been filled. You are advised to fill your form yourself. You should not share registration password with any unauthorized person.
Is it compulsory to take the print out of the final filled choices?	Yes, This is necessary to retain as proof of filled choices.
iii) Related to payment	
How can a candidate deposit the Registration fee?	A candidate can pay Registration fee online through Credit Card/Debit Card/Net Banking /RTGS/NEFT etc.
What is Bank Account Details (For Post Matric Scholarship / Refunds)?	Enter your personal (Candidate's) bank details only where you want your refunds (if any). If the details are incorrect in that case refund will not be processed.
What if my Choice filling option does not activate after making online payment?	This situation can occur in case your online payment is not successful on the Payment Gateway. In such case you can wait or pay Counselling fee again. The earlier fee will be refunded by the payment gateway. In case of any query you can submit your grievances online.
What is Security Fee Amount?	All candidates who wish to participate in the second round of counseling and want to opt for State Quota Seats in Government / Government Aided Medical / Dental Institutes only shall be required to pay fee of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. 5000/- for SC / BC / PWD / EWS) through online payment mode. You should complete your registration process and form, MODIFY Your CHOICES and LOCK your choices as per the schedule. In case, you edit your application form but do not lock the choices, your last saved choices will be considered. It is once again informed that If you fail to complete your form and lock choices again, your last saved choices after (for this round) will be considered. The Department / University / Admission Committee shall not be responsible for any delay / non submission of application form by the candidate in completing the registration and choice filling process.

i) Related to Seat Allotment	
What is the process of allotment?	Allotment is done on basis of merit, choice /preferences filled and available seat matrix.
What happens if I do not pay fees for the seat allotted to me?	You will not be given admission.

What documents must be uploaded by us?	Marksheets, Caste certificate, PWD certificate domicile etc. The list of desired documents will be displayed in your login.
When will the classes begin?	Please keep in touch with the College where you get admission.
iv) Related toUpgradation	
If I am not satisfied with the seat allotted to me in any round then can I fill fresh choices in the subsequent round?	Yes. You have to fill fresh choices in the subsequent rounds as per public notice.
If I do not get any seat allotted in the subsequent rounds then will my previously allotted seat remain with me?	Yes. Your originally allotted and joined seat will be retained by you.
If another seat is allotted to me in the subsequent round and I change my mind and want to retain the seat allotted to me in the previous round, then can I do so?	No. If the candidate gets another option, the seat allotted to him/her initially will be cancelled and the candidate will have to accept the "upgraded" seat. In any case, such "upgrade" candidate will not be allowed to retain the seat initially allotted. Therefore, the candidate must take great care in choice filling for "upgradation".
